A Roadmap on Implementation and Sustainability of Cancer Control Actions will be the main deliverable of this Joint Action.

The general objective of the iPAAC Joint Action (JA) is to develop innovative approaches to advances in cancer control. The innovation that will be covered within the JA consists of further development of *cancer prevention*, comprehensive approaches to the use of *genomics* in cancer control, cancer information and *registries*, improvements and *challenges in cancer care*, mapping of *innovative cancer treatments* and governance of *integrated cancer control*, including a new analysis of National Cancer Control Plans.

The key focus of the Joint Action will be on *implementation*, reflected in the key deliverable: the **Roadmap on Implementation and Sustainability of Cancer Control Actions**, which will support Member States in implementing iPAAC and CANCON recommendations.

To support the development of the Roadmap and to ensure a useful instrument for policy makers and their administrations, (health) representatives of Member States are invited to participate to the Governmental Board. Twice a year, the GB will meet to be updated on the iPAAC activities and main achievements and will provide advices, support and insights on the content and the format of the Roadmap.

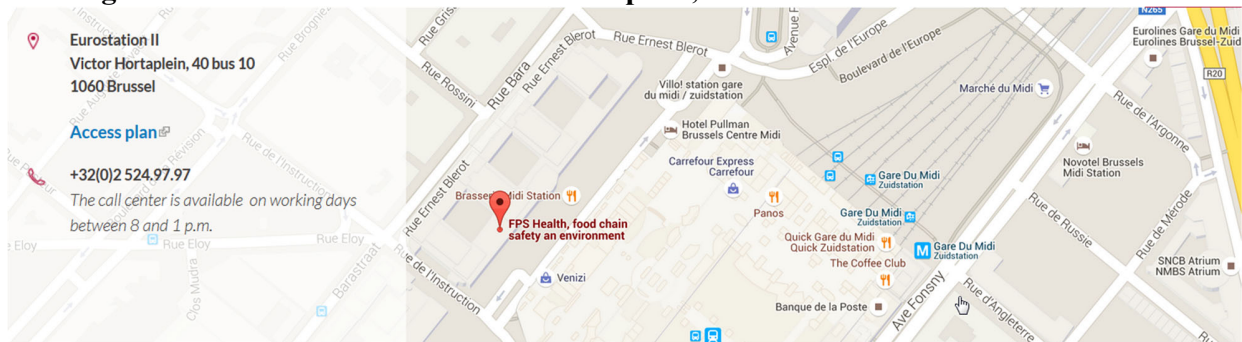
