# WP4 state of play: CCPIS

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“**WP4 CCPIS**”: *in-depth qualitative interviews with EU MS policy makers, health administrators & experts*

## Objectives:

- Identify examples of cancer control programs implementation
- Understanding the experience of cancer control actions implementation (*what are the key – overall needs/challenges?*)
- Collect information on the relevant contextual features for cancer control programs implementation

-> focus on **innovative approaches** (i.e. overcome challenges, solve practical issues, etc.)

# WP4 Cancer Control Policy Interview Survey (CCPIS)

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## Methodology

### **1°) Preparatory Phase**

Reading & documenting (desk research-> country profile)

### **2°) Field work**

On-ground data collection: in-depth qualitative interviews (use of a semi-structured interview guide)

### **3°) Follow-up**

Internal verbatim Country Report +

Summary Report: key contextual features; list of topics related to **implemented 'innovative' cancer control policy programs/actions**

→ Validation (+additional documentation)



# WP4 Cancer Control Policy Interview Survey

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## 25 countries visited:

France (July 2018 & June 2019), The Netherlands (September 2018 & July 2019), Spain (October 2018), Finland (October 2018), Germany (November 2018), Norway (November 2018), Croatia (November 2018), Slovenia (November 2018), Denmark (December, 2018), Malta (January 2019), Luxembourg (February 2019), Hungary (February 2019), Italy (March, 2019), Slovakia (March 2019), Bulgaria (April 2019), Serbia (April 2019), Belgium (April, 2019), Cyprus (May 2019), Greece (May 2019), Lithuania (April, 2019) Portugal (May 2019), Ireland (June 2019), Czech Republic (September 2019), Austria (September 2019)

# WP4 Cancer Control Policy Interview Survey

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## Data collection through interviews

- Detailed & reliable information, not exhaustive
- Possibility to probe & complement
- Interaction of actors from different fields
- Time demanding
- Interactive, dynamic work process
- Learning by doing

# WP4 Cancer Control Interview Survey

## Information received?

- Contextual features related to health care system/cancer control policy
- Cancer control (policy and care) framework
- For each domain: organization models, general features, 'implementation confounders'
- Reported issues and priorities : ***commonalities and differences***
- Concrete examples of implemented actions
- Remaining challenges

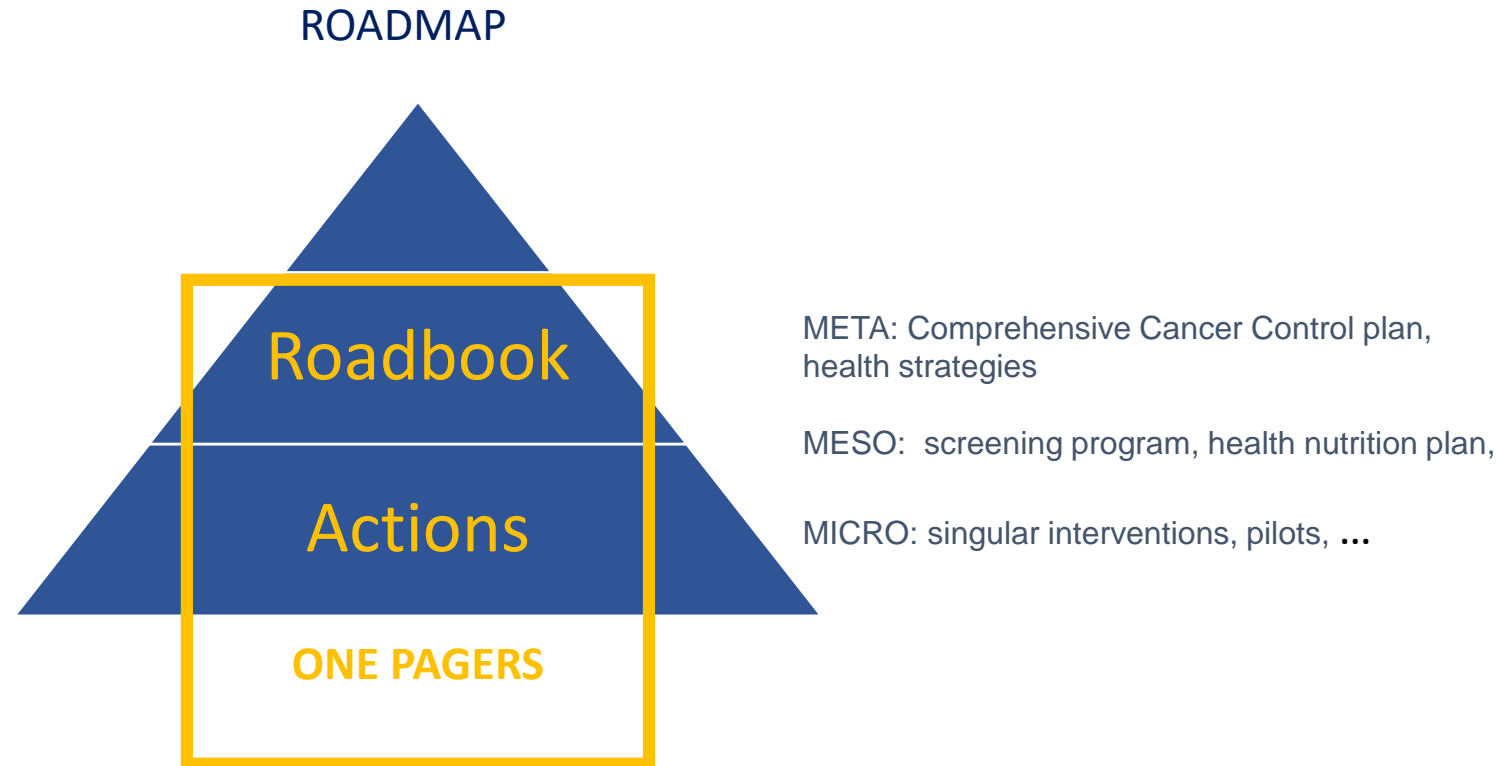
# WP4 Format of the Roadmap

## Concept Roadmap

= Framework providing an overarching view on how a broad challenge is being approached over a particular time in a particular space

Level	Scope
Roadmap	Strategic overview of the response to a broad overarching challenge
Roadbook	Integrated set of (interrelated) actions to address a need/ fill a gap in a domain of a broad challenge
Action	Set of activities realizing particular steps of a plan to achieve a concise output
Plan	Structured description of the different steps in an action

# WP4 Format of the Roadmap



**One-pager**: is the IPAAC building block aiming to provide a common structured representation of essential information provided by the MS (CCPIS) and the WPs on innovative implementation activities in cancer policies (roadbooks, actions, pilots, **factsheets**, novel approaches, ...)

## *What's the Roadmap?*



IT tool

Digital and searchable repository

Support for cancer control program implementation

Information structured by cancer control domains: primary prevention, screening, diagnostics & treatment, care



## *What's in the Roadmap?*



3 types/level of information

- Concrete examples of implemented cancer control actions in EU MSs ('one pagers')
- Concrete examples of cancer control implementation plans ('one pagers' and related documents)
- Theoretical /scientific frameworks related to cancer control implementation (**Toolbox**)

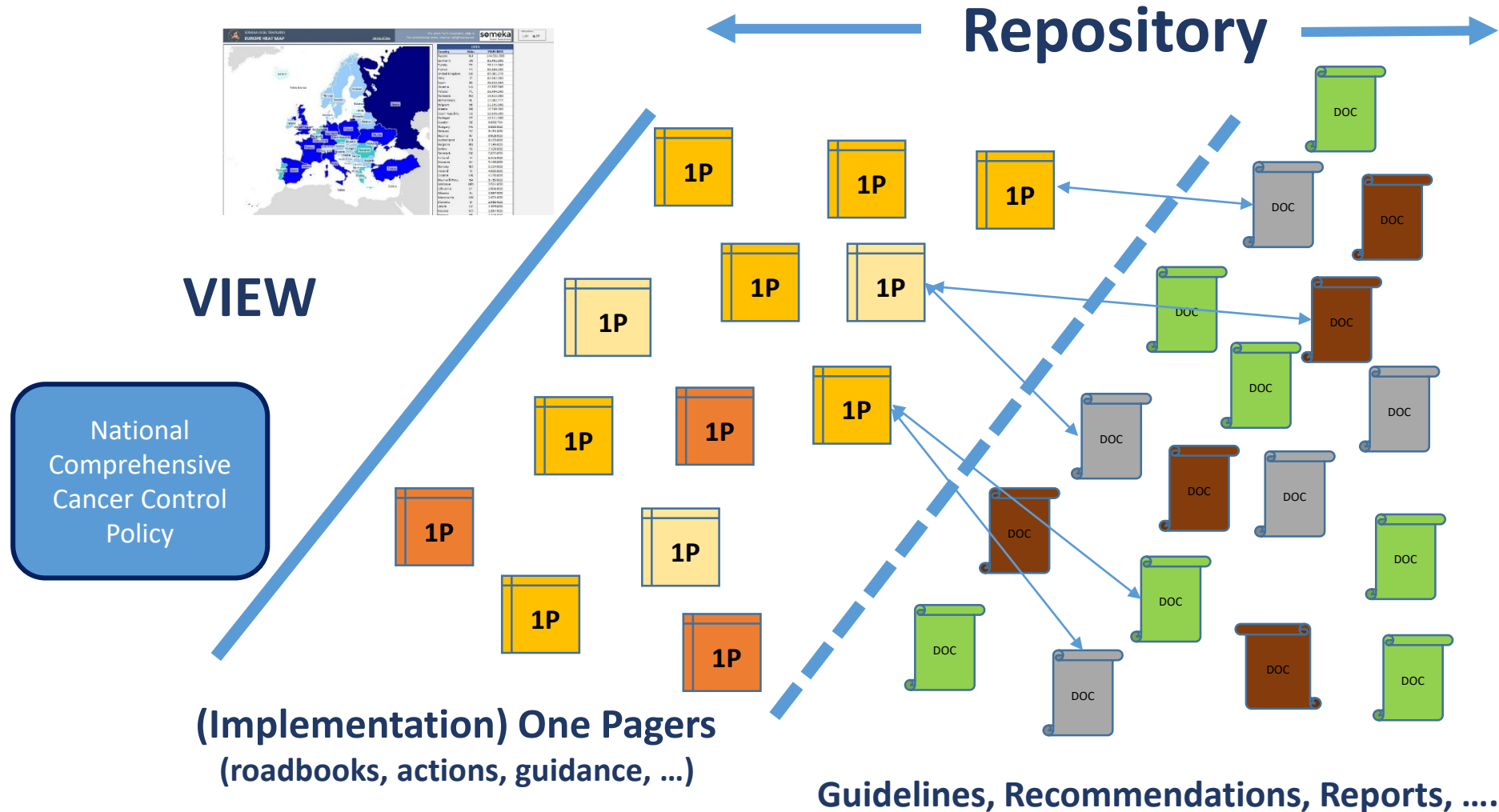
# WP4 Format of the Roadmap: a 'Mutual learning platform'
